515 children have come through our gates in need of love, care, and protection! 286 community kids have attended our school. There are over 3,000 people who have been or are being impacted through Challenge Farm! In addition to caring for the children, Social Work staffers offer counseling and parenting lessons to all our families. Our staff provides for their families because of being employed at the Farm. Calculating the ways all the children, families, and staff are helped, there are over 3,000 people impacted! This doesn't include our visitors and staff over the years! Many lives have been touched and changed because of these precious kids.
