Our staff recently visited a municipal market in the little town of Kiminini. They were told by the area chief that there's been an increasing number of children in the market. Could we please help, even come and pray for the kids? Challenge Farm is the first organization to come to that area and rescue children. We've rescued 3 boys so far. Girls as young as 14 have been taken into prostitution. **There are so many kids who gather late at night until the early morning hours.** Both the chief and police have given our staff their full support and protection. Much prayer is needed!

- Our staff to know how to proceed with so many children
- The children to be willing to be rescued and healed
- For the older girls, who after a certain age are very difficult to help. Pray that God will reach these girls.

A JOURNEY TO A SMILE...

Emmanuel comes from a difficult background; his mother passed away when he was 2 months old. He faced significant neglect and abuse where he stayed until he ran to the streets to find refuge. Emmanuel was later rescued by another relative, but the abuse continued, and he returned to the streets. A friend told him that the Challenge Farm staff were interviewing kids in Kitale and convinced him to go. Emmanuel was rescued and brought to the Farm!

Emmanuel has shown remarkable growth and resilience! He embraced the values taught him and has become very responsible. He often takes initiative with chores like sweeping and washing cups and plates without being asked. Emmanuel would like to be a pilot when he grows up. **We're dedicated to supporting his journey and many others like him!**

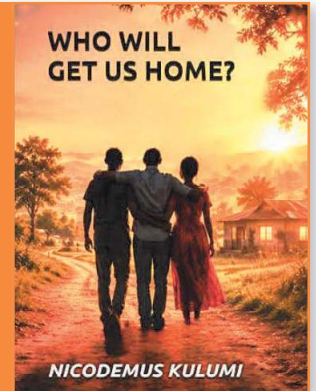
